



2021 Harvard Virtual Social Impact EXPO – FAQs for Employers

1. What if I don't have a full-time job to post. Can I still attend?

- Yes. Please share whatever information you can about how your organization hires, the recruiting process, typical interview questions, what you look for in a resume, and when you are likely to be hiring.

2. Can I change my session time after I register?

- Yes, you can change your session in the system until Feb 22nd (when attendee registration begins).
- To do this, use your *Confirmation Number* from the registration email to log into the event system.
- Then, click on *Modify* at the top of the screen, Click *Unregister* on your original session, and register for a new session from the available session times.
- **Please note:** if you change your session AFTER Feb 22, those already registered will be removed from your session. If you need to change your session time after Feb 22, please email us.

3. How many students will be attending my session?

- It can be hard to anticipate exact numbers in advance; however, typical virtual group sizes range from 10-30. Occasionally sessions can have up to 100+ attendees.

4. Who are the job seekers?

HGSE students and alumni:

- Most HGSE students are in a 9-month master's program and are graduating in May 2021.
- This year, we also have a large population of part-time students who will graduate in May 2022. These students may be seeking summer opportunities.
- Occasionally, doctoral students join us as well.
- Students will be joining us from around the world. The largest populations of current HGSE students outside of the US are in India and China.

Harvard College and Graduate School of Arts & Sciences (FAS):

- The College and FAS students are a combination of undergraduate, master's, & PhD students. They are seeking full-time positions as well as summer positions and internships.
- This event is open to all Harvard students and alumni. As such, there may be students/alumni from multiple schools at your sessions, including students from the Kennedy School, Divinity School, and Graduate School of Design. Most attendees are likely to be HGSE students.

2. Will we be receiving students' contact info ahead of time?

- Yes, we will share the list of students who have registered for your session in advance of the event.
- You will also receive a link to the **HGSE Resume Book** and the **Harvard College / FAS Resume Books**.
